KENTUCKY MEDICAID PARTNER PORTAL APPLICATION

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Updates to PT 26

Provider Type 26 Residential Crisis Stabilization Units (RCSU) will notice two changes in Partner Portal when navigating through screens during a New Enrollment. First, Providers can no longer select "Other Address" on the 1.7 Address Information Screen. This has been updated because PT 26 is an Entity and can only have one Physical Address on file.

Additionally, the following question has been added to the 1.1 Basic Information Screen: "Are you providing substance use disorder Residential Services?". Users who answer "Yes" to this question are required to have a DMS Provisional Certification or an ASAM LOC Certification in order to proceed with a New Enrollment. Certification details must be added to the 2.3 Certification Information Screen and the certification documentation must be uploaded on the 8.0 Document Upload Screen.

Re-Design of the Correspondence Tab

The correspondence tab has been re-designed to improve correspondence loading speed and search function efficiency. The screen now displays the most recent 90 days worth of correspondence. Additionally, when searching a correspondence date, the range selection cannot exceed 180 days. Informational bullets to reflect these changes have been added to the correspondence screen.
